European solar industry calls for publication of results of anti-subsidy investigation against China

EU ProSun, representing the majority of European solar manufacturing, welcomes today's announcement by the European Commission that it will continue the anti-subsidy investigation into Chinese solar imports, and looks forward to the prompt disclosure of the Commission findings.

Milan Nitzschke, President of EU ProSun said: "The Chinese communist government subsidizes the production and export of solar modules with billions of euros, which allows Chinese manufacturers to offer products for dumped prices over sustained periods. Market-based companies have no chance against such tactics. China's destructive dumping and illegal subsidies have already cost thousands of European manufacturing jobs. We know from our own calculations that the subsidy percentage in Chinese solar products is a double-digit figure, and expect the European Commission reaches similar findings."
